To all parents of students from classes KG1 to Class 12

This is the season when many children become prone to infectious diseases <u>like</u> chickenpox, mumps, Hand foot & mouth disease & measles.

In case your child suffers from any one of these diseases, he/she should be sent to school only after the given quarantine period is over.

In case a child is suffering from viral fever, cold & cough he/she should be sent to school after 5days.

Students who have tested positive for Covid-19 may come to school only after the quarantine period of 10 days. This must be followed strictly.

When the student joins school after the quarantine period, he / she must bring a letter from the doctor and submit it to the School Nurse before joining class.

Our nursing sister will examine the child before he/she is declared fit to attend classes.

Quarantine period for

Chicken pox - 10 - 14 days (according to severity or till scabs fall off)

Mumps - 5 –6 (days till swelling subsides)

Hand foot & mouth disease - 3-6 days

Measles -7 - 10 days Covid 19 -10 days

When you are asked to collect your child from school by the school nurse, please ensure that you collect him/her within half an hour.
